

Professional Certificate in Quantitative Text Analysis

(In person, 4 months part time)



Introduction

The Professional Certificate in Quantitative Text Analysis introduces students to various computational text mining methods in social science research with a focus on hands-on analysis of real texts. Students will learn to write code that extracts useful information from large textual data sets and develop an

independent research project of their choosing that relies on computational text mining methods.

This course is delivered over a 12-week period allowing you to fit your study alongside work, family or other life commitments.

Programme Highlight

The Professional Certificate in Programming for Social offers students a combination of a solid understanding of social science theory with the technical ability to understand the most common data science technologies.

Course Content and Structure

This Professional Certificate comprises one 10 credit module Quantitative Text Analysis. Meetings consist of a combination of lectures and lab sessions in which students work through various text mining methods and tools.

Throughout the course, students are encouraged to work on their own interests, by developing an indepth research project that relies on computational text mining techniques.

Career Opportunities

Graduates from this programme will be ideally positioned to apply their newly acquired computational text-mining skills to redirect their careers in government, think tanks, political campaigns, interest groups, and the civil service. Furthermore, the combination of a solid understanding of social science theory with the technical ability to explore large text data sets, brings a unique addition to any data science team, in the corporate sector, the nonprofit sector, or within IT companies.
