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<p>This half-day workshop by Prof. Mike Kerr, Clinical Professor at the Institute of Psychological Medicine and Clinical Neurosciences, Cardiff University will be of interest to those involved in supporting individuals with intellectual disability who have epilepsy.</p>

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<p>The workshop will comprise interactive discussion with delegates to understand the assessment of individuals with intellectual disability who have epilepsy, how epilepsy impacts on quality of life, the reduction of risk and how to achieve best outcomes from treatment.</p>
