Description

This module, while intended to develop participants' all-round mastery of Italian, focuses principally on the comprehension and translation of challenging Italian prose and on advanced translation into Italian. Various linguistic registers are explored, from the literary to the semi-colloquial and from the narrative to the analytical. Students who achieve at least a B grade in this module will be deemed to have reached CEFR Level C2.

Learning Outcomes

On completion of this module students should be able to write: 1. a satisfactory English translation of challenging Italian prose; 2. a satisfactory Italian translation of complex English prose.
